JW Support is a foundation that provides assistance to the poorest of the poor in the promotion of education and "fair trade".

**Bangladesh** is one of the poorest countries in the world. Famines, floods and bomb explosions occur on almost a daily basis. Yet, despite these constant disasters, there are people who try to make positive changes. I have personally witnessed this during my travels across Bangladesh. Everywhere I saw great efforts being made to improve desperate conditions. Individuals help themselves and their fellow man earn a livelihood and initiate small projects to help educate, feed and shelter their children.



JW Support is committed to support these initiatives by:

- ❖ Supporting fifty children in shelters,
- ❖ Equipping a local hospital,
- ❖ Selling fair trade handicrafts.

- ❖ Maintaining a school for girls from slum areas



#### Shelter and education

We run a shelter for about fifty street children in Savar, a suburb of Dhaka, the capital of Bangladesh. We provide accommodation, three meals a day and education for these children, whose background is really heart breaking. They mostly lived on the streets before we started looking after them. Additionally, we provide financial support for the education of fifteen other adolescents.

Please help us to shelter, feed and educate these unfortunate children!

#### Your assistance is needed. It costs you:

- ❖ € 35 to monthly adopt a child
- ❖ € 18 to provide meat for a day
- ❖ € 10 to provide rice for a day
- ❖ € 24 for one basic meal for all children (without meat or fish)
- ❖ € 4 monthly school-fees for one child

#### Education and vocational training

One of our co-workers started a small school for girls in one of the slums of Dhaka, the capital of Bangladesh. These girls come from poverty stricken families that are forced to send them to work to supplement the family income. These girls arrive at school with an empty stomach. We provide them with a daily healthy meal.

He also started a vocational training in sewing and embroidering for teenage girls and young mothers. After the training they are able to earn enough money to take care of themselves and their children.
